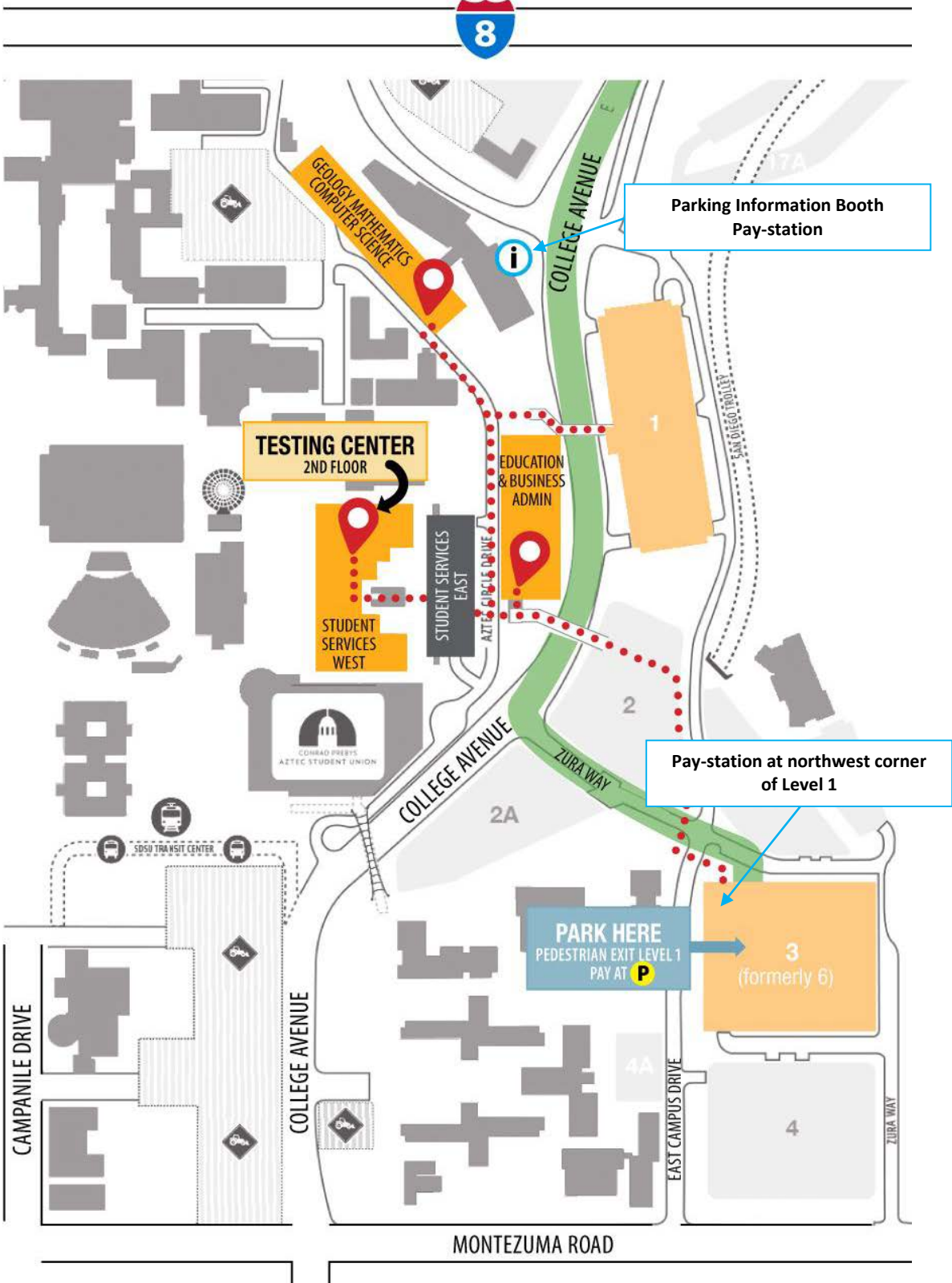


DIRECTIONS & PARKING INFORMATION

IMPORTANT: SDSU Testing Services (Student Services West, Room 2549) does not have its own address. 5500 Campanile Drive is the address used by the entire university, so GPS-related software may not direct you to the correct location on campus. Visitor Parking

Visitors must purchase a permit to park at SDSU. Permits are required at all times including evenings, weekends and holidays. There are a few options from which to choose.

- (1) You may purchase a pay-station permit from the Parking Information Booth (located in the drive-through on the northwest corner of College Avenue and Canyon Crest Drive) or from Parking 3, Level 1.
- (2) You may use the **PayByPhone** (<http://bfa.sdsu.edu/campus/parkingtrans/pbp.aspx>) app in all visitor and student lots.
- (3) You may purchase a guest permit for the day in advance from the **Aztec Parking Portal** (<http://bfa.sdsu.edu/campus/parkingtrans/parkingportal.aspx>). Detailed parking information can be found at the **SDSU Parking & Transportation** web site (<http://bfa.sdsu.edu/campus/parkingtrans/>).

Important: Individuals taking paper-based group exams (ACT Assessment, CHES, CNET, GRE Subject, LSAT, MPRE, NCE, and SDSU placement/proficiency exams) must follow the parking instructions and report to the location indicated on the Admission Ticket. Failure to park in the assigned parking location may result in a citation.

Public Transportation

The **SDSU Transit Center** (<http://arweb.sdsu.edu/es/virtualtour/transit.html>) serves the San Diego Trolley (Green Line) and several bus routes.
